Letter from the Board

Unanimous Choices

Jay Weber and Fred Kremer were unanimous choices to be re-elected as officers to Willow Creek III board of directors. Jay was named board president and Fred will continue as treasurer.

Both were nominated by fellow board members during the November HOA meeting following last month's annual meeting.

Newly elected board member Laura Ream

will serve as vice president, taking over for Bob West who finished his term on the board. Bob Bartlett was named secretary, replacing Chris Mumfrey whose term also expired.

Rounding out the six-member board are Jerry Grant, who joined Laura as the second "new comer," and Mike DeRosario.

The board is in the process of filling the vacancy left by Bob Correll who resigned during his first year on the board.

Board Adopts 2018 Budget

The Willow Creek III Board of Directors has approved the 2018 General Operating budget totaling \$570,000.

The board voted 5-0 (new member Laura Ream was onboard a plane during the vote) to approve the expenditures after a five-person budget committee spent most of one weekend mulling over the numbers and projecting cost increases for 2018.

The result of their labor is a dues increase that will take effect Jan. 1. Single-family homeowners will pay an increase of \$10 per month to \$102, and town home owners will see a \$5 hike to \$140.

The dues increase is driven by a number of factors, including but not limited to maintaining community property, operating the swimming pool (including more days and longer hours) and overall building and landscaping improvements.

Recent contingency costs from the October heavy wet snowstorm have used up some of the cash in the General Operating Fund. That, and other costs, have made an impact on how much cash carryover is available for the 2018 budget. Some of the contingency costs included trimming the tall trees and chipping the tree limbs in the common areas and homes.

The 2017 General Operating budget is \$568,000, and total expenses for next year are projected to be \$576,000. However, the HOA will use \$4/month of the cash carryover from 2017 to fund the 2018 budget, thus lowing the budget to \$570,000.




