The policy on garbage can storage is very clear. They must be stored out of sight either behind the fence or in the garage. Specifically, the policy states, "Alongside the house is unacceptable." And while it may be convenient for the homeowner to store garbage cans next to the home, this is considered an eye-sore for the community. As the guidelines state, "Realtors hold open houses and show clients our neighborhood on the weekends, and we owe it to them and our fellow homeowners to present Willow Creek III in a good light."

The average price of a Single Family Home was at \$728,385 in June, with Condos/Townhomes holding an average price of \$440,066! Wow is an understatement! These prices surely don't feel like a market shift at all, but we will probably start to feel the market soften during the second half of the year!




