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## Letter from the Board

Greetings, Willow Creek 3 members. Here is our update for our projects.

**Tree replacement.** This is in the operating budget; we are planning to replace them in 2022. We are open to suggestions about where to replace. Our arborist has a list of the locations, and has suggestions on which species would be best.

**Welcoming Committee.** Diane Kremer has resigned from the Welcoming Committee after 12 years of service. Thank you, Diane, for doing an excellent job! We are searching for someone to take over the position. The committee delivers a bag of vendor/community information to new members of the HOA.

**The Board's Amenities and Grounds Committee** consists members Fred Kremer, MaryBeth Doerr, Dave Markenson and Luke Adeline. We will create a 10-year plan for replacing/renovating the amenities. The Reserve Study will be used as a guide, which forecasts when items are expected to be replaced. We will be evaluating other improvements to the pool area. Everyone knows that the asphalt sidewalks in all 4 greenbelts are in bad shape after 40 years of wear and tear, and those will be a high priority for replacement. These replacement projects are expensive and cannot all be done in one year, so the 10-year plan will serve to guide the future Boards in this. These projects will be funded by the General Reserve Fund, which receives part of our monthly dues.

**Tennis Court replacement.** The post-tension concrete was poured last year and the fence posts have been placed. The fencing material was ordered in November 2021 and will hopefully arrive soon; this has been affected by the tight supply chain and high demand for construction materials. The basketball hoops were already delivered.

**Card reader system.** We will work on this in the spring. This system will provide access to pool, tennis courts and clubhouse with one card. We will get all the bids and select the vendor.

**HOA Townhome sidewalk hazard repairs:** the Board will have a walk-through in the spring. HG will give us an update on the vendor who will do the grinding.

**Architectural Control Committee (ACC)** we are forming the committee. The committee will elect the chairperson. The ACC has suffered from some chaos over the last 2 years, partly from the COVID restrictions. We all want the covenants and by-laws enforced in a fair manner. The ACC will re-evaluate the policy book to clarify standards and procedures. The ACC remains an important part of the community to keep the whole neighborhood neat and that helps to sustain our property values. With the warmer weather coming, we'll do the spring walk-thru.

**Website:** Thank you to Bob Correll for getting the willowcreek3.com website back up and running. Bob thanked HG's Sybil for helping out. We are keeping the current informational format.

**Clubhouse:** please contact HG for reserving the clubhouse. Over the year, there is an average of 10 rentals per month. Earlier this year, the Board approved a change to the clubhouse rental fee to \$65 for homeowners and \$100 for business.

**Social committee** is in a holding pattern, because of the COVID restrictions

**Swimming Pool.** The Board will evaluate daily operating hours and total days open, and there may be changes to those hours and days.

**Paver project.** HG will check on vendor pricing for 5 rows each year for the next 3 years to finish the project by 2024.

**City street (not alleyways) repairs** – if you see potholes in the city streets, please submit a request for repair using the City of Centennial website [no, it will not cost you to report it]: <https://www.centennialco.gov/Government/Departments/Public-Works/Street-Maintenance>.

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



- You are required to clean the clubhouse after use and take away all trash. A trash dumpster is available. A broom, mop, vacuum, garbage bags and cleaning supplies are provided. The clubhouse will be inspected after use and your deposit could be withheld.
- You can decorate the clubhouse for your event as long as all decorations are removed, no marks are left, no damage is done and the clubhouse is left clean.
- You may prepare food or have food catered. Alcohol is allowed as long as all laws are followed, it is kept within the clubhouse and it is not sold. The pool and tennis courts are not included in the rental.
