Letter from the Board

June Board meeting attendees were Aidan, Luke, Fred, Marybeth, Jerry, Eric, David on zoom, Sybil/HG on Zoom.

Forum. Monika Dasio said thanks to Aidan for his ACC leadership during the transition. Request replacement tree near 8013 S Quince Way, north side to walking path.

Forum. Homeowner told us about sprinkler issues resulting in flooding in a crawl space at 7844 E Phillips Circle HG were made aware of the issue. With no action by HG, Aidan talked to Jeff Stevens to look at it which he did & made the necessary repairs. Reminder: if there are sprinkler issues you must email the board's wc3directors@gmail.com.

Forum. Homeowner mentioned the 8160 sink-hole that the neighbor's repair vendor fixed but the soil settled again. Aidan will reach out to the neighbor.

Landscaping vendor JBK manager Reg mentioned that the spring services were completed. Thursday is the normal mowing day. Fallen tree branches broken from heavy snow are on the common grass areas. Aidan asked Reg to remove the fallen branches, and Reg agreed. Reg asked about the bid for the mulch project; we had asked HG to get bids 2 meetings ago, but this project will be tabled till later. There was discussion about converting some common area landscape areas that are being sprinkled to turn them into xeriscaping Aidan will meet the irrigation vendor and JBK to plan accordingly. Reg mentioned that an orange cone had been present on the common lawn near Phillips place and Phillips circle, over a water meter with lid missing. Told Sybil about it a while ago, the board will reach out to Denver Water

Pool - Vendor Perfect Pools did not attend. Sail shade not up yet at time of meeting, Aidan had arranged for the sail shade to be reinstalled the day after the meeting.

Social Committee – pool party in May went well. Next event – we are planning for the 4th July party.

Swim Team reps Steve and Julie attended. First home meet was Saturday 11 June. They requested that the sail shade be reinstalled. They discussed sharing the key set with vendor Perfect Pools. Asked Sybil from HG for a new set, but did not get it. Aidan will give the team the code for the key's lockbox. Steve told us that the team has 56 resident and 50 non-resident swimmers, which is in compliance with the previous MOU requirement of at least 50% residents. There is no current MOU with the swim team Aidan mentioned this is another reason why we need to update the MOU so that everyone knows what is required. Julie and Steve will ensure that toilet paper and soap will be replenished, and the bathrooms will be cleaned, during/after the swim meet; a volunteer checks the bathrooms once per hour during the meet. BOD is not attacking the swim team; we have to answer other residents' questions. BOD is emailing each other to iron out the details of the MOU. Aidan asked the team to please ensure that cars are not parked in the townhome alleyways or extra spaces. We must have the answers so that we can answer any questions. Team will make efforts to clean up after the meets. Board will allow handicap access to the clubhouse bathroom during the meet. Next home meets are 25 June and July 9. 

WCTC Tennis Liaison Bonnie Baker said tennis courts are open. 25 users are on the online scheduling system, which has been posted on the bulletin board. Courts are being used for league play, around 1-to-3 nights a week, using only courts 1 and 2, as in the MOU.

Tennis Courts. Shade structures for the courts have been ordered. The card reader system is scheduled to arrive August 17th 2022. Emptying trash cans is in the landscaping contract. Bonnie derived rules on the scheduling; you make the reservation then you must be on the court; you cannot make it for anyone else. Such points will need to be addressed in the MOU. Bonnie mentioned that after a month they can give out the rules in an email. She will have Sybil/HG send the email. Question: is the Tennis Club procedural committee working on the MOU? Mary Beth said no. There is a need for a trashcan at the kids court. Need a tray for 4. Need number signs for courts 1234. Mary Beth will get the signs and trays. Board approved the purchase. Send email to Aidan. Please summarize in an email what the usage is for the courts, and the scheduling.

Amenities committee -we will have the plan to present at the next board meeting.

Architectural Control Committee (ACC) – the Spring walk thru is done. The notices will be sent out in the near future (129 homes got 98 violations). For ACC changes send to ACCwillow3@gmail.com. We have 6 ACC members.

Website. No report.

Townhome Pavers. This project was started in 2010 in which the HOA paid for installing the pavers around the townhomes. Our goal is to do five rows this year. Aidan asked HG in January to get the bid.

Minutes for May's Board meeting are not accurate so we will not bring that up for an approval vote this meeting. Financial reports are not going to be approved because inaccuracies. We will discuss attorney report and delinquency report in executive session. Sybil/HG said the board packet was delayed by 2 weeks because of the financial system conversion and some training.

HOA Sidewalk Hazard Repairs & Townhome Alley paving. Sidewalk Milling, Grinding, Shaving was not done May 9th. This project is on hold.

Community dumpster day was delayed because of the snowstorm. We will re-schedule for a later date.

Amenities committee to discuss tree replacements and schedule. Board will address the townhome retaining wall replacement in September October, after peak vendor demand has subsided. Mulch project bid was way high so we revisit that later.
