Letter from the Board

Willow Creek III Annual Board Meeting 10/14/2022

The meeting opened at 6:10 pm at the WC3 clubhouse. There were many homeowners in attendance in anticipation of the guest speaker Mike Sutherland, Centennial Council board member. Mike spoke for 45 minutes and fielded questions from homeowners on three topics that are important to the Willow Creek 3 community.

The County Line fence was the #1 concern. Mike expressed that this was on the City's radar but there was no immediate plan to replace the fence. Many homeowners brought up the aesthetics, sound mitigation and safety concerns pertaining to the fence. Councilman Sutherland stated he would bring the feedback to his fellow councilmen and this issue to the forefront. He also stated that reaching out to him via email would help reinforce the community's concerns.

The need for speed control measures around Caterpillar Park was the #2 concern. Councilman Sutherland suggested this too was on the City's radar. In the next few weeks, a decision will be made by the councilmen on what measures will be taken to control the speed of vehicles driving on E. Phillips Circle in and around the playground and soccer fields.

Permitting short-term rentals in WC3 was the #3 concern. This community believes this is becoming a major issue. Councilman Sutherland stated that the City has restrictions in place for such establishments. The Willow Creek 3 BOD will implement policies that reflect the City's requirements and will act accordingly.

Following, Councilman Sutherland's Q & A, homeowners were given the opportunity to ask the board any questions (4 board members were in attendance) in an open homeowner forum. Truck parking, ongoing sprinkler issues & the County Line fence were discussed.

After proxies submitted and votes via homeowners in attendance at the meeting were counted, it was determined by Row Cal we did not have a quorum to approve the 2021 minutes. Forty-one homeowners were represented at the meeting; the requirement of 51 fell short by 10. There were two open positions on the board and two homeowners submitted applications, which in turn resulted in an uncontested election.

Homeowners Steve Lobell and Diane Kohler were elected. The board thanked Fred Kramer for his tenured service of many years as a board member in many fashions to the community. Outgoing board members were not in attendance,

After introductions to the new board members, the 2022 annual meeting was adjourned.



Willow Creek Tennis Club

WCTC is a partnership of the three HOA in Willow Creek. That partnership is defined in a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) and that MOA is being updated. If there is something you feel needs addressing- contact your HOA.

WC2 Tennis Committee needs volunteers - if you're willing, contact the committee.

Overall 2022 was a successful year of tennis for Willow Creek Tennis Club (WCTC). Perhaps a little too much success: at times there were more players and not enough tennis courts.

Player feedback from the season just comlted clearly identified:

- a preference not to play on the alternate surface tennis courts (Quebec courts);
- need for more social space: more tables and seating;

Based on how many HOA resident players are on a team approximately \$1800 in registration fees was refunded. The WCTC recommends that the refunds stop to improve the financial position of the WCTC. A question has been raised *why do HOA residents pay for tennis courts twice? Dues to the HOA, and then additional registration charge for WCTC? WCTC owns nothing – why do they get to charge HOA residents for use of the HOA assets. le tennis courts?*

As has been the situation previously, in 2023 the WCTC proposes when WCTC does not have enough WC tennis courts available, WCTC will try scheduling South Suburban Parks and Rec (SSPR) tennis courts. SSPR reported increased use of tennis courts and may not have enough tennis courts to cover WCTC needs. If SSPR tennis courts are not available, WCTC teams can stagger start (see CTA Rules) or find courts outside WC, at the teams's expense.

When NTRP ratings come out WCTC will create a 2023 Wanna Play list.

WCTC intends to require

- team rosters have 150% of players needed for match play
- teams roster HOA residents first, including if they want to play up a level

Rostering players who are "playing up" will be based on Captain and player desire

Any plans for 2023 could be altered depending on how the HOA updates the MOA.




