

Before beginning any exterior modifications, improvements, or repairs to your property, please remember that all requests must be submitted to and approved by the ACC first. This includes but is not limited to landscaping changes, paint colors, fencing, decking, and structural modifications. Submitting your request in advance helps ensure compliance with our community guidelines and prevents any potential issues down the road. Request forms can be submitted through the management company website.

#### **Trash Can Storage Guidelines**

As a reminder, trash cans should not be visible from the street except on designated collection days. Please store your containers in your garage, behind your home, or in another location that screens them from public view. This simple step helps maintain the attractive appearance of our neighborhood that we all value.
